If you have already updated to iOS13, and your Kevo lock is currently functioning correctly, please disregard this message as there is no reason to go through the steps below.

With the introduction of iOS 13, Apple has improved location privacy when you are using Wi-Fi and Bluetooth. As a result, when updating from earlier versions of iOS, you will be required to accept the new iOS 13 Bluetooth permission for all iOS apps that wish to use it.

Please follow the steps below to ensure the Kevo app and Kevo lock are working properly:

If you have already updated to iOS 13

 When accessed or started, iOS should automatically show a notification that will ask you to "Allow" Bluetooth permissions for the UniKey app. Once you select "Allow", no further action is required.

If you have NOT updated to iOS 13 yet

 After the update, your phone will restart. At that point, if you do not see a notification or pop up for Bluetooth Permissions, simply locate and open the application. You should be able to "Allow" Bluetooth permissions at this point.
