Before you paint

Start with the right tools! You'll need:

- 13mm pile (semi-smooth) roller and paint tray or power roller
- Polyester or nylon brush
- Drop cloth, painter's tape and clean rags
- Step ladder
- Soap and water for clean up

- Patching compound and putty knife to fill holes
- Sandpaper (120 grit) and pole sander to smooth rough surfaces
