2015 Early Childhood Application



Purpose

The H-E-B Excellence in Education* Early Childhood Award is designed to support public or private schools that focus on the care and education of children under the age of five. The purpose of the award is to offer support to help create or enhance Kinder Readiness programs that prepare children to enter Kindergarten socially and academically ready to learn.

Eligibility

Eligible institutions include: all public schools or private schools working directly with children under the age of five, who are currently located within the H-E-B service area.

For the purpose of this Early Childhood Application, schools located within 60 miles of an H-E-B or Central Market store are considered in the H-E-B service area.

Criteria

To apply, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Demonstrate both a passion and historical commitment to offering quality early childhood education and care in the community.
- Be successful in preparing students to enter Kindergarten both socially and academically ready to learn.
- · Exhibit innovation and creativity in the classroom or program setting.

Evaluation Process

All complete, submitted applications will be screened and then scored by a panel of professional judges comprised of educators, administrators and community leaders. Five (5) applicants will be selected by the panel and recognized as finalists.

Applications from the five (5) finalists will then be reviewed by a statewide selection committee. The overall statewide winner will be announced during a recognition dinner and celebration to be held in May 2015.

Awards

The five (5) finalists will each be presented with a check for \$5,000 to apply towards enhancing their existing Kinder Readiness activities or creating new programs for the target population. A representative from each finalist will receive an all-expense paid trip to the awards celebration in May 2015. This includes a special reception in their honor. At the recognition dinner, the overall state winner will be announced and awarded an additional \$25,000 grant to apply towards either enhancing existing Kinder Readiness activities or creating new programs for the target population.

Application Guidelines

Applications may be submitted online or mailed in.

To complete an online application, please visit heb.com/education. The online application will be available until midnight on January 11, 2015.

If an applicant is mailing in an application rather than completing it online, please follow the guidelines below:

- · Campus or Agency Name must be at the top of each page.
- •Use no more than two pages (8.5" X 11") to answer each question.
- · Use no smaller than 10 pt. type and no less than 1.5" line spacing.
- · Please retain a copy of the application for your records, as materials will not be returned.
- · Applications must be postmarked by midnight on January 11, 2015, to be eligible.
