


#3268 BED SAFETY RAIL INSTRUCTIONS



Your young child will sleep safe and secure in their own Young America bed with the use of a pair Bed Safety Rails. Proper assembly will ensure every effort has been made to design these Bed Safety Rails with your child's safety in mind. They are certified to meet all safety requirements from ASTM International.

Thank you for purchasing a Young America Safety Rail. If you find that you are missing a part or if a part is defective in any way, contact your Young America Baby retailer for assistance.



SUFFOCATION AND STRANGULATION HAZARD Gaps in and around bed rails have entrapped young children and killed infants.

- NEVER use with children younger than 2 years old. Use ONLY with older children who can get in and out of adult bed without help. NEVER use in place of crib.
- NEVER use unless bed rail is tight against mattress, without gaps, and at least 9 inches from headboard and footboard. Do not fill gaps with pillows, blankets, or other items that can suffocate children.
- NEVER use on toddler bed, bunk bed, water bed, or bed with inflatable mattress. Use ONLY on adult bed.
- Use only on Young America adult beds with mattress and slat roll.



ENTRAPMENT HAZARD


- NEVER use bedrail without properly securing bed rail to bed. Incorrect installation can allow bedrail to move away from the mattress, which can lead to entrapment and death.
- Discontinue use if damaged, broken, or if any parts are missing.



STEP 1: Install Pair Bed Safety Rails to Assembled Bed:

NOTE: WHEN INSTALLING PAIR OF BED SAFETY RAILS, THE BED SHOULD BE ASSEMBLED WITH THE SIDE RAILS IN THE LOW POSITION ONLY!!

- 1. Install 2 Bed Safety Rails as indicated below. The Safety Rail Brackets on the Safety Rails fit into slots in the slat bearers on the side rails (Refer to Section "A") AND engage on the Top Edge of the Bed Rails (Refer to Section "B").
- 2. When properly installed,
 - a) The bottom of the Bed Safety Rails must rest on top of the Slat Roll
 - b) The Safety Rail Bracket MUST engage on the top of the Bed Rail (Refer to Section "B").
 - c) The Bed Safety Rail Warning Label MUST not be visible (Refer to Section "C").



Additional Warnings

• KEEP THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

- Before each usage, inspect bed for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges. DO NOT use bed if any parts are missing or broken. Ask your dealer or write to Stanley Furniture, 200 North Hamilton St No. 200 High Point, NC 27260 for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed.
- DO NOT substitute parts. Use only parts supplied by manufacturer or parts of comparable quality and equal dimensions. Do not allow ends of screws or sharp edges to be exposed.
- If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.

Cleaning

Mix together a mild solution of gentle dishwashing liquid and water, apply to crib surface using a soft clean cloth lightly dampened in the solution. Rinse with clear water again using a soft clean cloth, then dry all surfaces thoroughly with a soft dry cloth. NO ABRASIVE CLEANERS, SCOURING PADS, STEEL WOOL, OR COARSE RAGS SHOULD BE USED TO CLEAN THIS FINE FURNITURE.

Periodic Maintainance

- 1. Periodically check to make certain all screws are fastened securely.
- 2. Check frequently that the bed safety rail brackets are inserted into the notches in the slat bearers.
- 3. Save this instruction sheet in the event you disassemble the bed safety rails and need to reassemble them. This instruction sheet will also be useful in identifying replacement parts if needed at a future date.
