

ASSEMBLY REQUIREMENTS: 2-Person Assembly

15 Minutes Assembly Time.

ASSEMBLY PREPARATION:

- I. Choose an assembly location that is flat and in close proximity to where the product will be used. Allow ample room to work.
- 2. To prevent scratching on finish: Assemble on a clean, soft surface such as carpet or on a cloth.
- 3. Remove all packing materials, staples and packing straps from the carton. Make sure to carefully un-pack the product.
- 4. Review hardware list and ensure all components are present and in good condition.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

- 1. KEEP ALL HARDWARE OUT OF CHILDREN'S REACH.
- DISPOSE OF PLASTIC PACKING MATERIALS IMMEDIATELY
 TO AVOID RISK OF SUFFOCATION TO
 CHILDREN AND ANIMALS.


ASSEMBLY PRECAUTIONS:

- 1. Identify the required parts and hardware prior to each assembly step.
- 2. DO NOT use power tools for assembly.
- 3. DO NOT over tighten hardware.Damage may occur.
- 4. DO NOT sit or stand on partially assembled product.

CARE AND USE:


- 1. For Residential Use Only (Non-Commercial).
- 2. Recommended for Indoor use Only.
- 3. DO NOT use product if components are damaged. Check all hardware periodically and re-tighten as necessary.
- 4. DO NOT sit or stand on product. Use only for intended purpose.
- 5. DO NOT drag product across floor. Exercise caution when moving product.
- 6. DO NOT place hot items directly on product surface.
- 7. DO NOT use commercial or harsh abrasive cleaners on surfaces. Wipe with soft,damp cloth.
- 8. DO NOT allow liquid of any kind to remain on product. Absorption may cause surface damage.

ENSURE ALL PARTS AND HARDWARE ARE PRESENT AND IN GOOD CONDITION BEFORE DISPOSAL OF PACKAGING.



STEP 1

- PLACE TABLE SHELF (D) ON A CLEAN AND SMOOTH SURFACE SUCH AS A RUG OR A CARPET TO AVOID THE TABLE SURFACE FROM BEING SCRATCHED.
- ALIGN LEGS (B) WITH TABLE SHELF (D) TO MATCH WITH BOLT HOLES AS SHOWN.
- INSERT BOLT WITH WASHER AND TIGHTEN COMPLETELY.



STEP 2

- PLACE TABLE TOP (D) ON A CLEAN AND SMOOTH SURFACE SUCH AS A RUG OR A CARPET TO AVOID THE TABLE SURFACE FROM BEING SCRATCHED.
- TURN (STEP 1 ASSEMBLY) UPSIDE DOWN AS SHOWN TO MATCH WITH BOLT HOLES WITH TOP (D)
