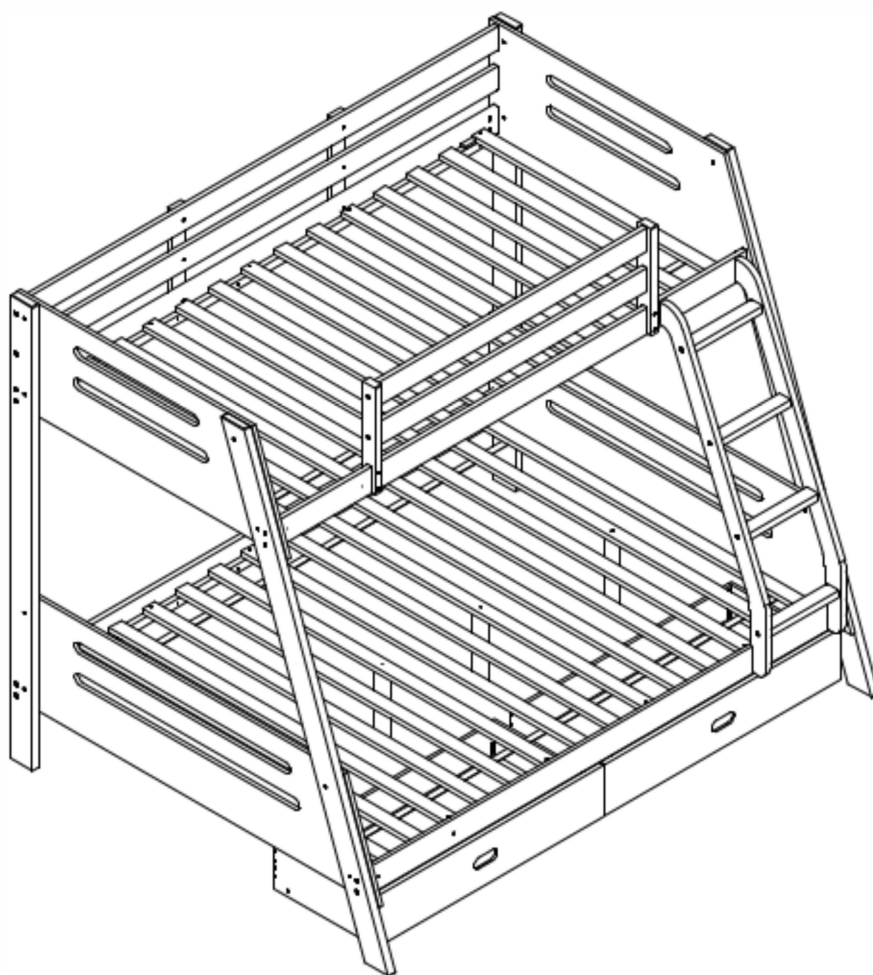

PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches and damages.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

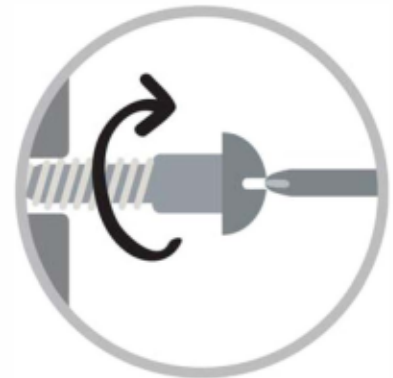
ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE



**FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES BELOW MAY

Position each part correctly
and insert screws or bolts into
their respective holes.



Turn clockwise to tighten and
only tighten when step is
completed or when instructed
to do so.



Use the appropriate hand tools
or power tools for assembly.
Select steps, such as tightening
screws and/or bolts, may require
hand tools to avoid causing
damage during assembly.



Save the instructions and store
any supplied tools for later
maintenance.



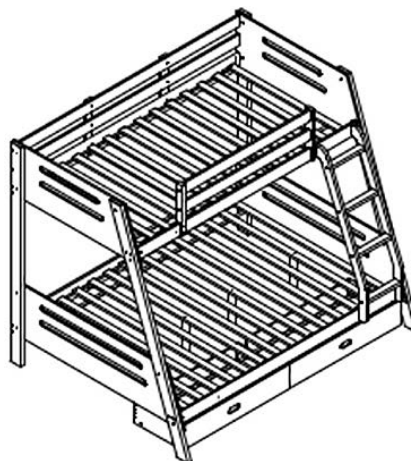
After two weeks, check and
tighten any loose hardware and
repeat again every six months
thereafter.

I. Insert wood dowels (#G) into the Left back post (#1) and the Left front post (#2).

II. Align the Left back post (#1) and the Left front post (#2) to the Left upper panel (#3) and the Left lower panel (#4). Secure by using the Allen wrench (#H) to attach Bolts (#C) into threaded insert (#E).

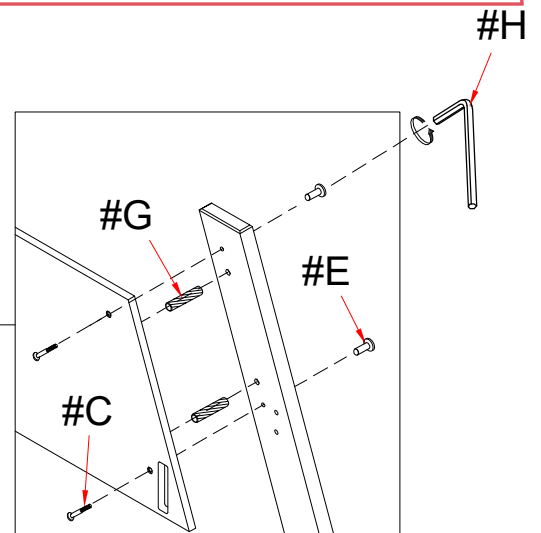
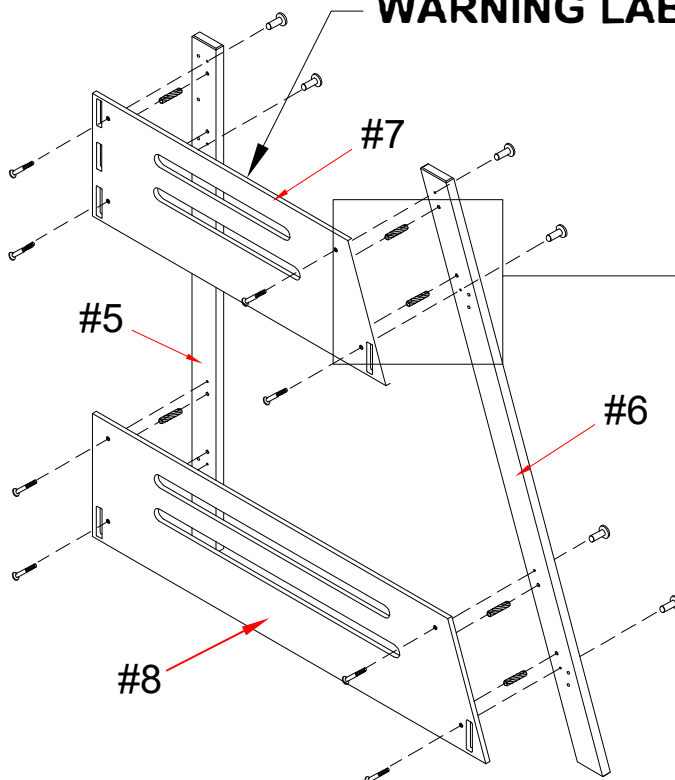

I. Insert wood dowels (#G) into the Right back post (#5) and the Right front post (#6).

II. Align the Right back post (#5) and the Right front post (#6) to the Right upper panel (#7) and the Right lower panel (#8). Secure by using the Allen wrench (#H) to attach Bolts (#C) into threaded insert (#E).

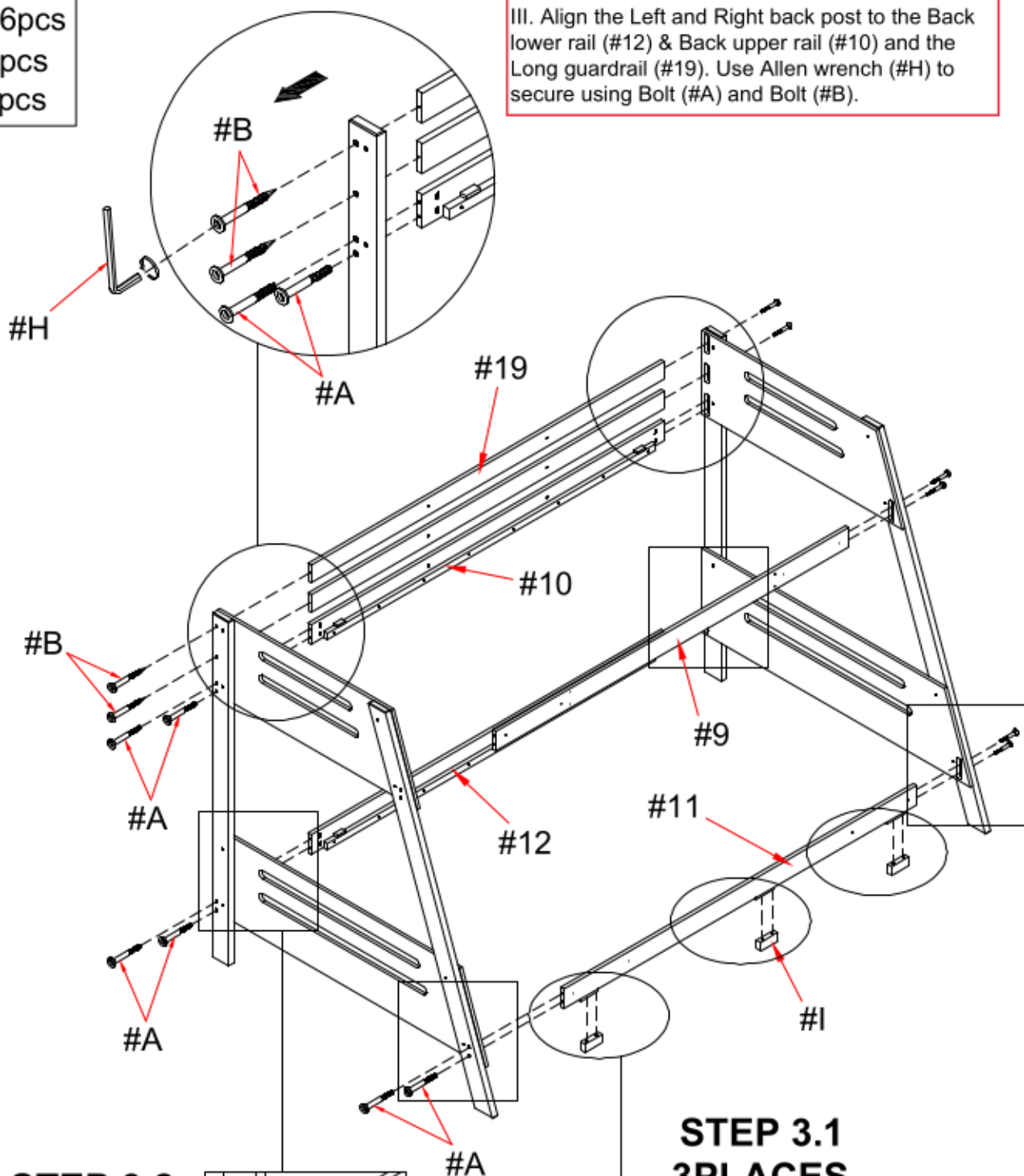

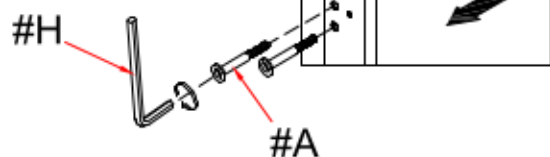


I. Insert Screw (#F) to secure the Wood rail (#1) to the Front lower rail (#11).

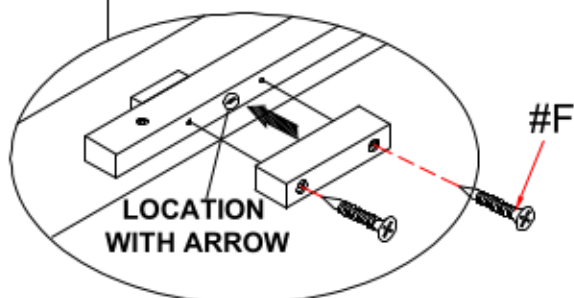
II. Align the Left and Right front post (#2, #6) to the Front lower rail (#11). Use Allen wrench (#H) to secure Bolts (#A).

III. Align the Left and Right back post to the Back lower rail (#12) & Back upper rail (#10) and the Long guardrail (#19). Use Allen wrench (#H) to secure using Bolt (#A) and Bolt (#B).

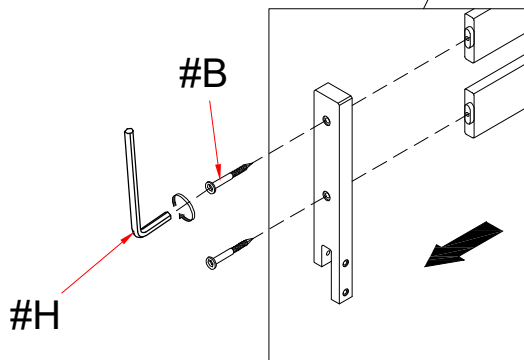
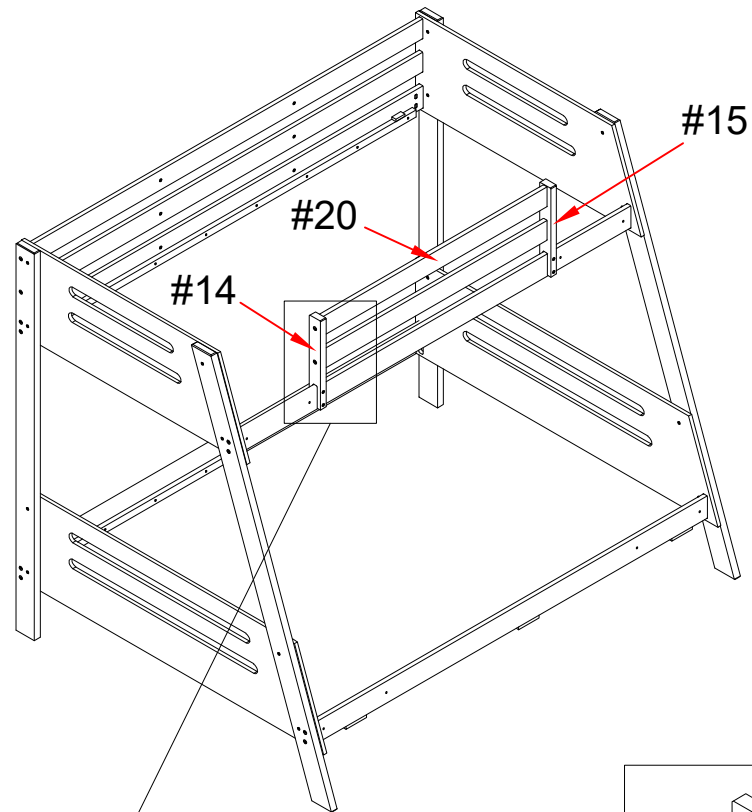




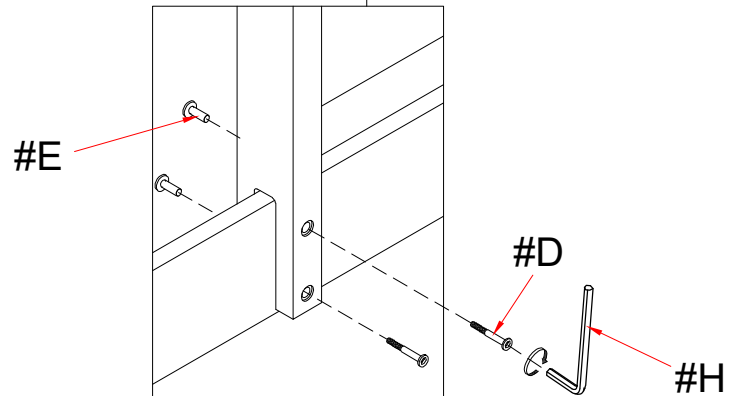
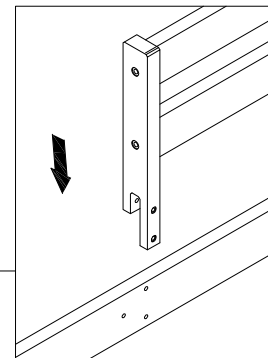
I. Align the Left attachment (#14) and Right attachment (#15) to the Short Guardrail (#20). Use Alien wrench (#H) to secure using Bolts (#B).

II. Align the Left/Right attachment (#14,#15) to the Upper front rail (#9) and secure by using Bolt (#D) with threaded insert (#E).

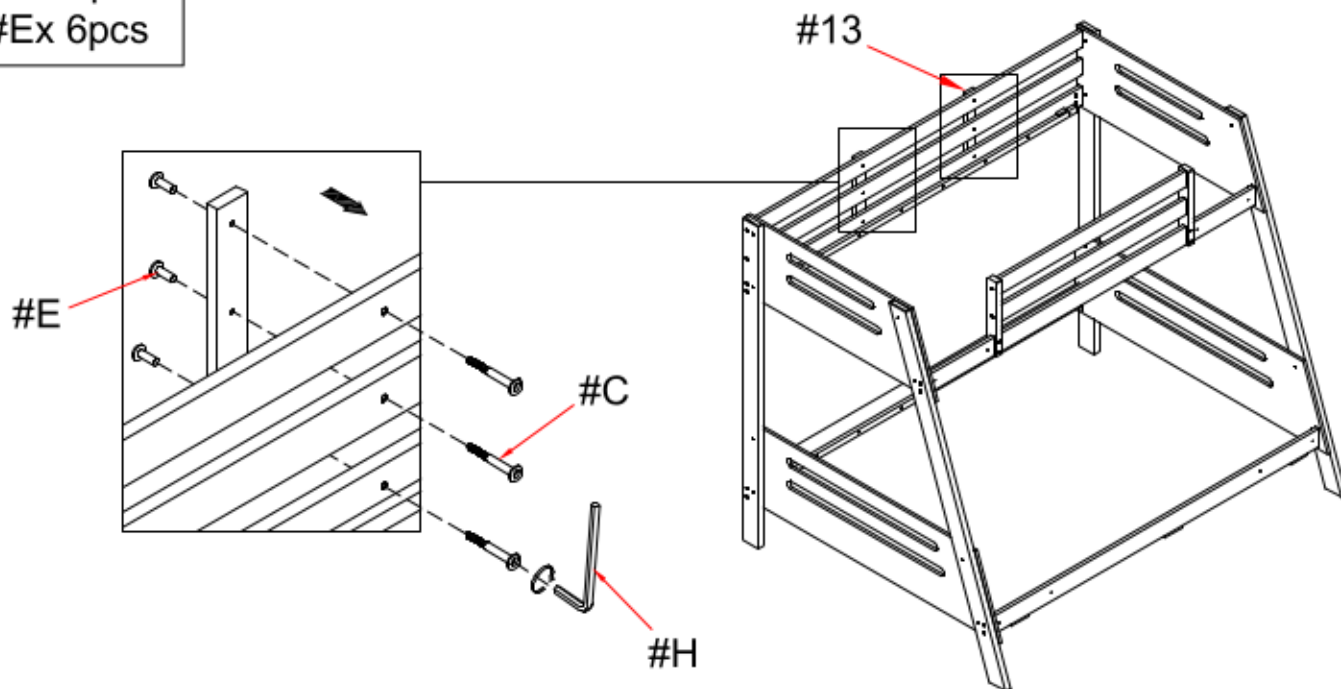

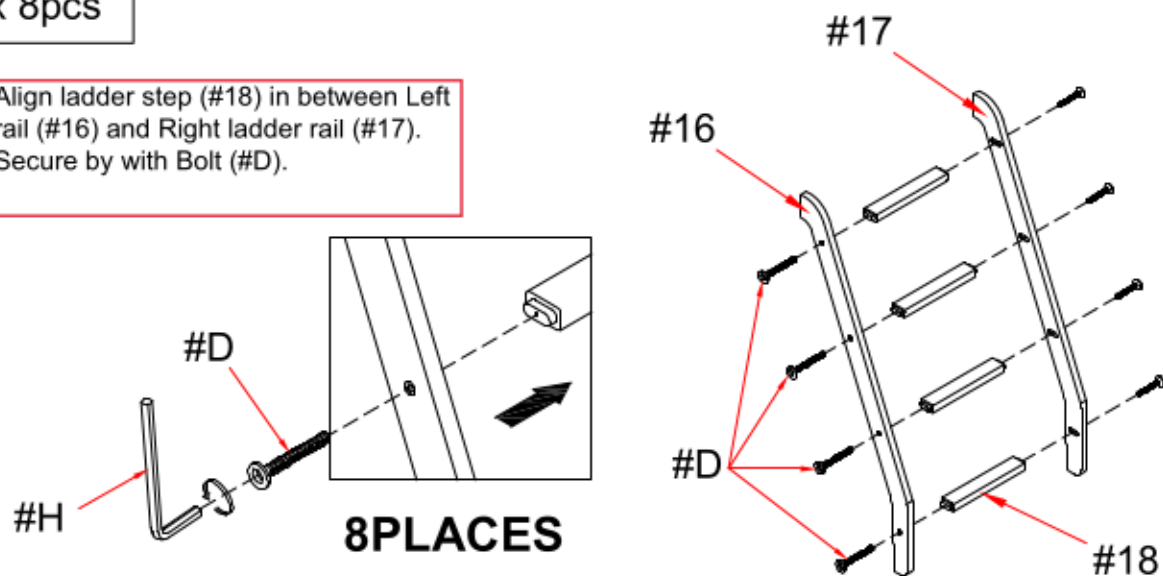
Align Guardrail support (#13) to the Long guardrail (#19) and Back rail (#10).

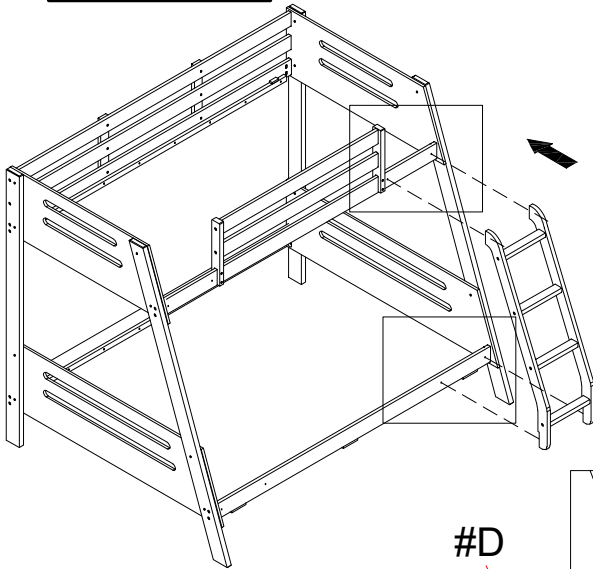
Align ladder step (#18) in between Left rail (#16) and Right ladder rail (#17).
Secure by with Bolt (#D).



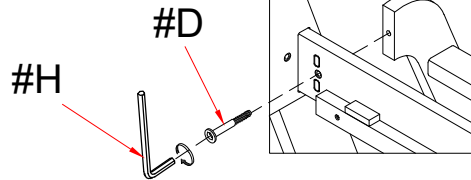


Align the ladder to bed on preferred side. Secure using Bolt (#D).

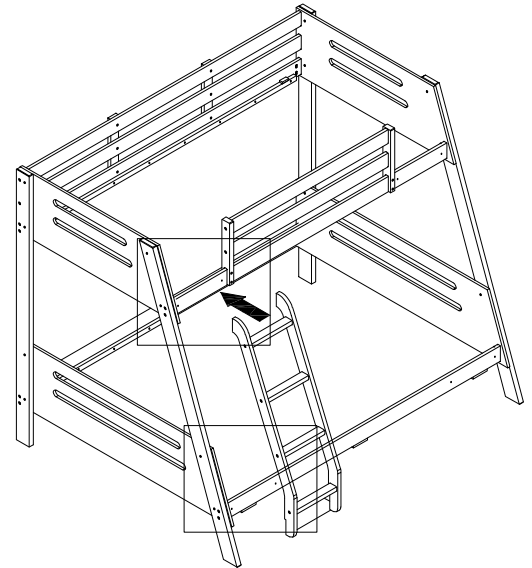

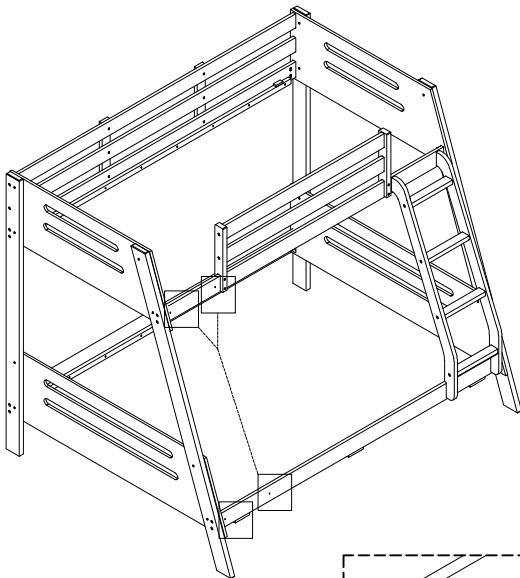

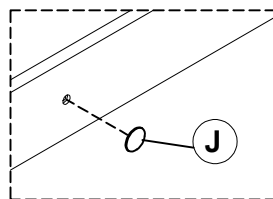


Align paper cover to bed on preferred side. Secure using Paper Cover (#J).

Attach the Bed slat support (#23) at the center of the Full slats(#22) with Bolt (#C) by using Allen wrench (#H). Spread slats (#22) over the bottom frame. Secure using screw (#F) and a Phillips screwdriver.

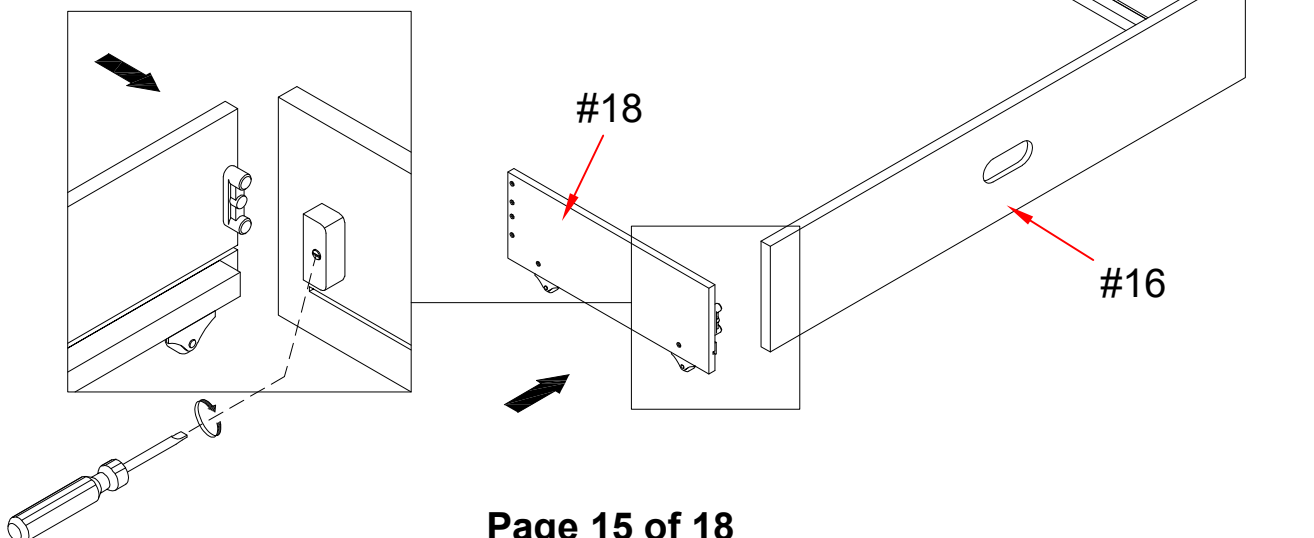
Spread the Twin slats (#21) over the upper frame. Secure by using Screw (#F) into the slat ends and using a Phillips screwdriver.

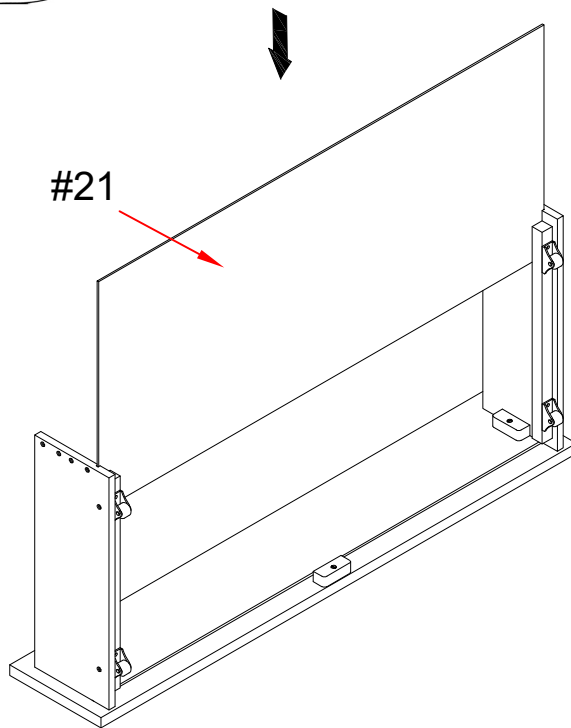
Align Drawer left panel (#18), (#19) to Drawer front panel (#16) and secure using the Phillips screwdriver.

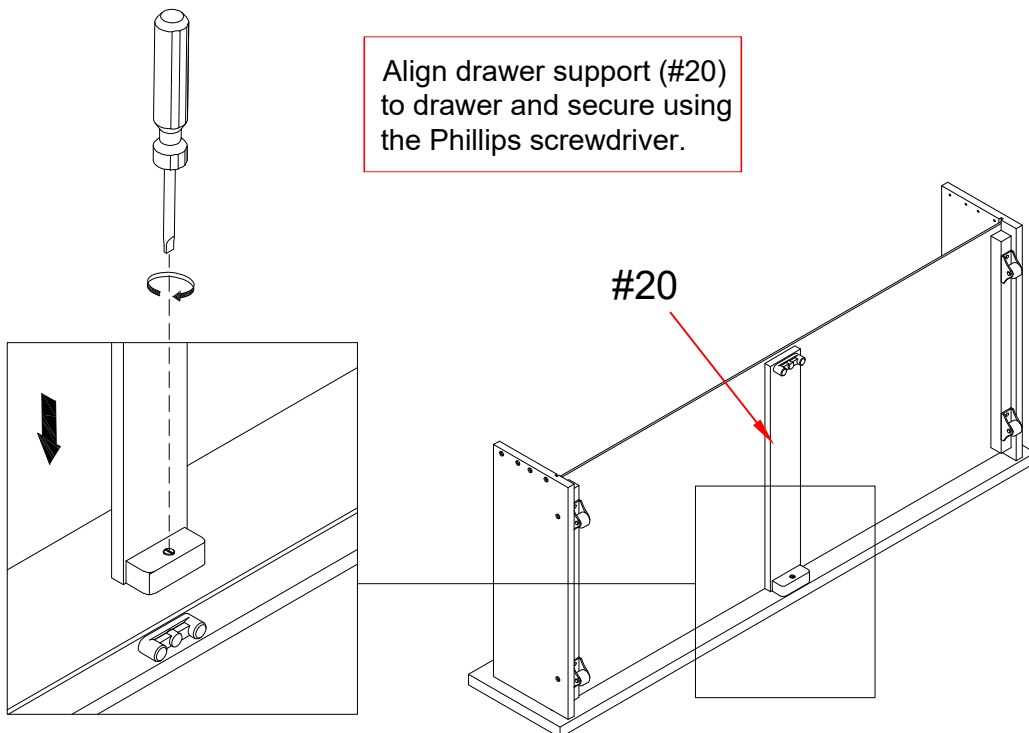




Insert drawer bottom panel (#21) to center drawer.



Align drawer support (#20) to drawer and secure using the Phillips screwdriver.

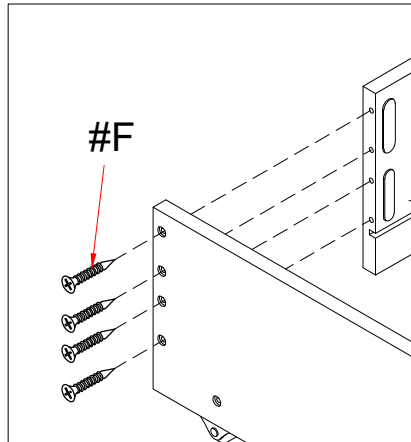

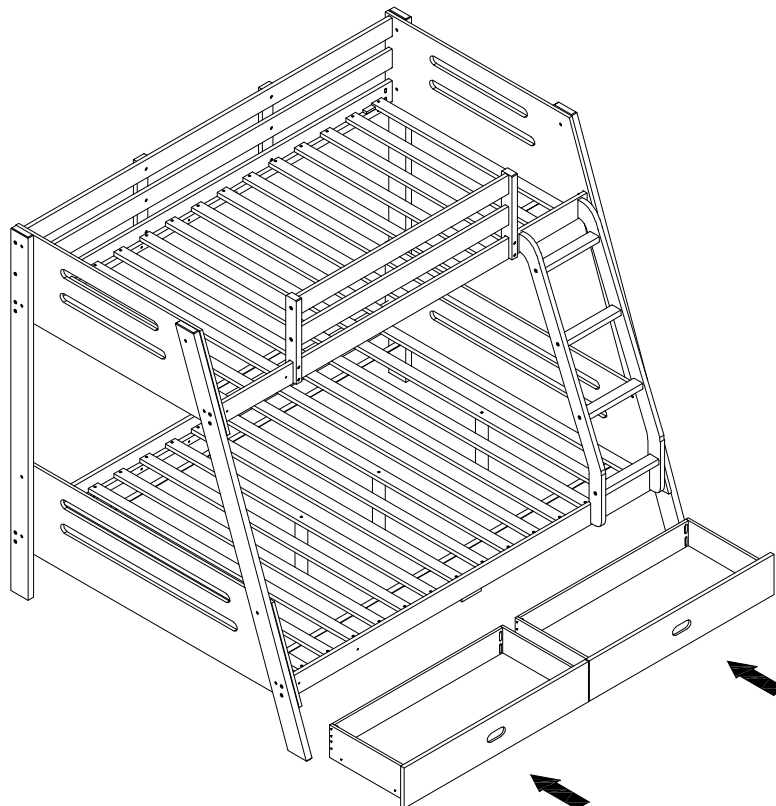
II. Align Drawer right panel (#19) to drawer back panel (17). Secure using Screw (#F) and secure using the Phillips screwdriver.

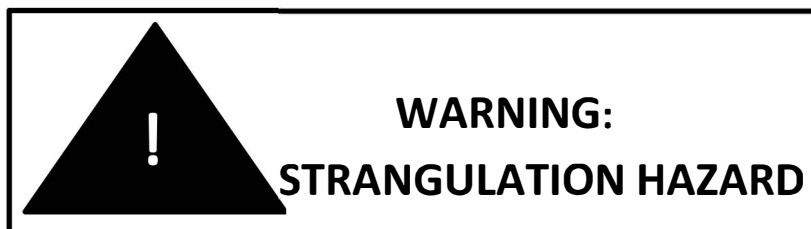
Lift, don't drag!

To avoid damage to product please always LIFT the product when transporting or adjusting the placement.

This product is intended for RESIDENTIAL USE ONLY and not for commercial use.

Safety Warnings for Bunk Beds

1. Read and follow the information on the WARNING labels shown on the end structure of the upper bunk and on the carton.
2. Do not remove warning labels from the bed.
3. Keep these instructions for future use.
4. IMPORTANT: The proper sizes for the UPPER TWIN –SIZE mattress should be 74" – 75" long and 37 ½" – 38 ½" wide with no more than 6" thickness and for the LOWER FULL –SIZE should be 74" – 75" long and 53" – 54" wide with mattress thickness at least 8" and does not exceed 11".
5. Surface of mattress must be at least 5 inches (127 mm) BELOW the upper edge of the guardrails.
6. The MAXIMUM weight capacity for the upper bunk is not to exceed 150 lbs.
7. Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
8. Periodically check and ensure that the guardrails, ladder, handle and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tightened and secured.
9. DO NOT allow horseplay, rough playing, or jumping on the beds and do not allow playing or hiding under the beds.
10. Always use the ladder for entering or leaving the upper bunk.
11. Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
12. Use of a nightlight may provide added safety precaution for a person using the upper bunk.
13. Always use the guardrails on both sides of the upper bunk.
14. If the bunk bed will be placed next to a wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.
15. The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses is prohibited.
16. No more than one person is allowed on the upper bunk at all times.
17. Always use the recommended size mattresses or mattress supports, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.



Objects such as, but not limited to, hanger, hooks, belts, bag, rope strings, etc. should not be hanged or used on or around the bunk bed.
